

Three Camp Scholarships Awarded

Fond du Lac County Audubon has awarded three camp scholarships through the Dave Stetter Environmental Education funds. Students receiving the scholarships are Joey Coleman of St. Mary's Spring Academy, Molly Fellenz of Theisen Middle School, and Macy Myers of Woodworth Middle School. All three will attend the "Outdoor Adventures in Recreation and Conservation Camp" at Sand Lake from June 19–21, 2019. Sand Lake Conservation Camp takes place at Camp Bird Youth Camp in Marinette County, Wisconsin near Crivitz. Operated by Marinette County Land & Water Conservation Office, this Conservation Camp provides positive educational outdoor experiences, helps foster appreciation and understanding of nature, and introduces a variety of opportunities in natural resources and conservation careers. Professionals from various natural resource and conservation agencies present programs on topics like wildlife, habitat, ecosystems, water quality, fisheries, forestry, and conservation career information. Experiences at the camp match the goals of the Dave Stetter Environmental Education Fund as hands-on outdoor experiences promote a deeper understanding and appreciation of the natural world.
