

2026 Summer Environmental Camp Scholarships Available for Middle and High School Students

Fond du Lac Area Bird & Nature Alliance (formerly Audubon) is offering Dave Stetter Environmental Education Middle and High School Scholarships for this summer. Dave Stetter, a science teacher at Goodrich High School, highly valued hands-on environmental education for instilling conservation values. The Wisconsin Land and Water Conservation Association sponsors a camp that offers such experiences. Students entering Grades 6 through 8 in the fall of the 2026–2027 school year may attend the Wisconsin Land and Water Middle School Conservation Camp, June 28–July 1, 2026. The camp is held at Camp Lakotah, Wautoma. For high school students, the camp is North Lakeland Discovery Center in Manitowish Waters, June 15–18, 2026 (Grades 9–12 in fall). While enjoying the outdoors and having fun, students will learn about the forest, water, and wildlife ecology, and conservation problem solving.
